President's Prop-Wash

RDRC Runway: Nu-Tech is still refusing to return my calls or emails. Their website has now been taken down and replaced with an under construction image. I have taken the steps of filing a complaint (#11085264) with the Better Business Bureau. Again, I will continue to push this issue with them. I am also starting to get quotes in from other paving companies to see what it would cost to correct the issues where Nu-Tech failed

and see what the cost would be moving forward for bi-yearly maintenance. I should have more information by next newsletter.

Budget Vote: When I created the budget for the club, my goal was to stick to the defined limits on each account unless there is a need or a request to exceed that budget allotment. At the last meeting a request was brought up. No motion was made, but I would like to treat this pending one-off budget spending like a club bylaw change by getting this information out in the newsletter prior to the meeting at which the vote will be held. The budget in question is the IT budget. Right now the IT budget is \$800 per year, which includes 12 months of DSL service at \$50 per month (\$600) plus \$200 for upgrades, repairs, etc. We spent \$100 on weather repairs and about \$50 for the new web cam on the north end. People were happy with the new north cam and would like to see the south end camera also replaced. My suggestion, if we do that why not go all the way and put back the 3rd camera facing east (the flight line). To add the east cam, replace the south cam, and replace the USB extenders for the 3 locations (north, south, east) to allow high bandwidth between the cameras and the computer I would like to request a one-time overage on the IT budget for at most \$350 (product, tax, & shipping) to perform this task.


